## *United Mission at Work in Nebraska*

Across the American Baptist Churches of Nebraska, United Mission giving tells a story of shared stewardship, deep trust, and faithful generosity. In recent years, that generosity has made meaningful ministry possible both in Nebraska and across the wider American Baptist family.

One of the most significant shared ministries in Nebraska is the Moses Merrill Camp & Conference Center—a 570-acre sacred space where lives are shaped through camps, retreats, and gatherings for people of all ages.

In recent years, we completed a \$500,000 renovation of Weaver Hall, including a new kitchen, updated bathrooms, and essential infrastructure improvements.

These upgrades ensure that the facility can safely and effectively serve guests for many years to come. We also completed a multi-year well project, drilling a new 300-foot well at a cost of more than \$100,000—an unglamorous but absolutely essential investment in the camp's long-term sustainability.

In ABC Wisconsin, Next Generation Ministries are a regional priority. This means that we expect youth (ages 13-17) and young adults (ages 18-30) to be present and active in our region and to be included in leadership when possible.

Not only does this mean our Nominating Committee has young adult representation to assure young adults are included on our Board of Managers and committees; it means that we offer scholarships for Baptist related events.

This is part of our budgeted spending using United Mission giving. We budget for scholarships to attend our Annual Gathering, the ABCUSA Biennial Mission Summit, camps, retreats, and other events related to ABC life.

We even sent two young adults to the Baptist World Alliance gathering in 2025, and have continued to have a strong youth and young adult presence at our regional events. In 2025, we increased our Next Generation Ministries (which includes campus ministries) from 7% to 10% of our entire budgeted expenses.

Our Outdoor and Camping ministries is another 37% of our budget and often focuses on children, youth, and families—so almost half is focused on ministry to families and next generations!

We encourage our youth and young adults to participate in leadership and decision-making as part of their discipleship in Christ, and as part of the American Baptist Churches of Wisconsin, and we budget for them to do so. We know that children and youth are not only the future of the church—they are the church today!



## How United Mission Fuels Innovation Through the Mission Initiative Fund

Every gift to United Mission is an investment in God's work. While many people recognize that United Mission supports the ongoing ministries of American Baptist Churches USA, fewer realize that it also helps launch new ideas and strengthen emerging ministries through the Mission Initiative Fund (MIF).

Under the United Stewardship Plan, 1% of United Mission gross receipts are designated for the Mission Initiative Fund (MIF). This intentional commitment reflects ABCUSA's desire not only to sustain existing ministries, but also to encourage innovation by investing in new opportunities for mission and ministry across the denomination.

The Mission Initiative Fund provides grants to ministries that seek to respond creatively to emerging needs and opportunities. MIF has supported initiatives such as new church planting, leadership development, community outreach, discipleship, creation care, justice ministries, and other projects that strengthen the witness of American Baptist churches and organizations.

*Innovation has always been part of the Church's mission. As communities evolve and new challenges emerge, ministries need the flexibility to develop fresh approaches to sharing Christ's love and serving others. Through the Mission Initiative Fund, churches and ministry partners are equipped to turn faithful ideas into meaningful action.*
