

# ABCUSA MATTHEW 25 GRANT APPLICATION

A generous donor has given a sum of money through American Baptist Churches USA to be used for programs that address "housing, feeding, education and health with regard to the less fortunate." A panel will select recipients for grants of up to \$5,000 largely based on the degree to which the funds will be used to directly assist persons in poverty. Ministries must be in relationship with American Baptist Churches USA to be eligible to apply, and only one application per church or ministry will be considered per year. Grant funds may not be used to fund staff positions. Grant awards will be sent to the ABC church or organization, checks will not be made payable to an individual or ministry.

#### **Caring for each other in the Gaps:** *Living through Suffering and Loss in the Elder Community*

Beginning this fall GAPS Ministries will offer an eight-session support group for people ages 50+ dealing with caregiving (emotionally, spiritually, and/or physically) of family and friends with chronic illness, cancer, mental illness, or other debilitating conditions. (A second eight-session will start in the winter of 2016).

It will also be open to elders who are facing losses and readjustments due to aging: physical illness, financial loss, loss of independence, loss through death of spouses and friends. Many people in our GAPS programs are on fixed incomes or have financial limitations due to the need to work less because of caregiving or illness. Cape Cod has a large elder population since we are a retirement destination; often the caregivers themselves are older and at risk for their own health problems and burn-out.

This program will minister to the whole person through prayer and relaxation techniques, facilitated discussion, and by sharing a nutritious meal together. Healthsigns Center has a long history of providing pastoral care, spiritual guidance, and hospitality on Cape Cod for all denominations and faith backgrounds. While there are many opportunities in our area for other kinds of support groups there are very few that help the caregivers with a spiritual component and hospitality. We also outreach to area congregations to create a rich ecumenical/interfaith experience of caring.
