MISSION: Our mission is to restore hope to the forgotten: the addicted, disabled, elderly, homeless, and hospitalized by meeting their emotional, physical and spiritual needs.

The Lakes Chaplaincy currently serves those who live and/or work on the eastern rim of Lake Winnipesaukee, NH and in Carroll County. The statics and signs are apparent in our region. Here poverty among families with children under 18 years of age in 2009 to 2013 families was 10.5%; overall children under 18 living in poverty was 11.8%. The annual average of unemployment in 2014 was 1,034. In 2011 Homeless Children/Youth was 161 and in 2012 was 178, and the number is greater today. Drug addiction and overdoses have risen so radically, it is publicly acknowledged by the State as "epidemic." Involuntary Emergency Admissions (IEA) have increased 50% since 2013 according to local law enforcement officials.

The Pew Foundation lists Vermont and New Hampshire as seeing the fewest people attending church in the country. NH churches are closing and the people groups in our mission statement are not being served on basic levels and fall into a chasm outside the church body. The "forgotten" we serve have been ravaged by unemployment, physical abuse, sickness, or other degrading factors. Many have issues with serious depression and anxiety. With the rapid rise in addictive behaviors, homelessness and property crime create the inability for employment. Municipal leaders and regional non-profits are seeing a significant rise in poverty resulting in endemic hopelessness. TLC meets individuals in the defined people groups one-to-one, with family members, and in small groups to helping them toward hope and healing.

Since The Lakes Chaplaincy began in September 2013, with the name registered with the State one month later; multiple individuals in all five people groups have experienced life transformations emotionally, physically, and spiritually.

USE OF FUNDS:

- Increase the number of people we serve; expansion of network.
- TLC travels throughout Carroll County, which is considered geographically ultra-rural. Staff travel and travel for individuals in need of attending therapeutic or support services (AA meetings, professional counseling, the hospital, etc.).
- Funding for limited food for those in immediate need, often when welfare and other resources are not available.
- Provide viable sources for daycare so parents can feel unrestrained to attend job interviews or programs fostering their recovery.
- Educational materials enable those we serve to look toward the church family to help support them. A supply of resource materials as well as Bibles are needed for this purpose.
