#### 3. ABCUSA Matthew 25 Grant

### Charleston Baptist Temple Demonstrates the "Hands and Feet of Christ"

Charleston Baptist Temple is a missional church with a vision of being a worshipping, nurturing community serving as the "Hands and Feet of Christ". We have contributed to the American Baptist Churches USA and the West Virginia Baptist Convention to extend our mission outreach internationally, nationally, statewide and within our own community. Charleston Baptist Temple has initiated an outreach ministry to directly assist persons in poverty by providing support to the Crossroads Men's Shelter, a rescue shelter facility for men located in our Church neighborhood in downtown Charleston, WV.

The purpose of the Matthew 25 Grant is to obtain funding to assist the Crossroads Men's Shelter in the following ways: supply food for their food pantry, provide the necessary equipment to serve meals productively in their kitchen, and purchase new bed linens.

Crossroads Men's Shelter is a refuge to men needing temporary housing. Residents receive three hot meals every day, as well as a hot shower, clean clothes and pajamas, fresh toiletries, and a clean bed. The facility serves between 150 and 200 meals per day, and it has a maximum lodging capacity of 75. The shelter is open throughout the day, and residents are welcome to access the facility whenever they wish. If after a short initial period a transient decides to make the shelter his home, he must commit to finding a steady job. Residents are attributed the dignity they deserve as human beings, but they are kept accountable for the management of their time and money. They are also encouraged daily in their spiritual walk. Many men have come to know Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, as a result. The Crossroads Men's Shelter is dependent on donations to maintain their facility and in need of support to continue this community service.

Through our Crossroads Men's Shelter Outreach Ministry, Charleston Baptist Temple has provided volunteers to prepare and serve meals, donated needed appliances and supplies for their kitchen; received a \$2000 donation for a garbage disposal installed for use in their kitchen. The Church conducted a rummage sale to obtain additional funding for the shelter. Working with the staff at the Crossroads Men's Shelter, the following have been identified as significant needs to maintain the shelter:

- The kitchen is in desperate need of assistance the kitchen pantry is not stocked with sufficient food to provide three meals a day there are no cabinets to store kitchen items.
- Although the shelter has a capacity for 75, the lack of bed linens prohibits them from housing at full capacity. Bed linens are needed, especially before winter.

The Charleston Baptist Temple appreciates your consideration of this grant request in the amount of \$4166 for Baptist Temple to continue our Crossroads Men's Shelter outreach ministry and fulfill our desire to be the "Hands and Feet of Christ". Thank you.
