We would also purchase a refrigerator to put in the Food Pantry. This would allow us to receive and store perishables, enabling us to provide more nutritionally balanced packages to our neighbors who come to us for assistance. Our church is more than 50 years and these areas have not been updated as we have a small (in number only) congregation. So, funds to do a renovation have not been available. Favorable consideration of this grant request will allow us to better serve those who come to us. Our Neighborhood Center (pantry and clothes closet) has been a staple in this community for many years. These funds would allow us to do it even better.

 The funding will help to provide food and clothing to individuals who come to the Luther Rice Food Pantry and Clothes closet on Wednesday of each week. With additional funding, we would be able to increase the amount of food and clothing that we could distribute. Individuals would be better assisted during their time of need and families would not have to go hungry because of what we could

These needs are not eligible under the terms of the grant as they are considered capital improvements.
