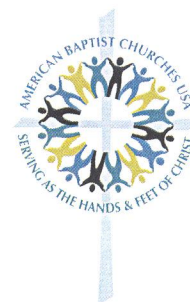

We are pursuing the purchase of a handicapped accessible van to augment the ministries of the church. The money for the purchase is not within the budget of First Baptist Church and will require above and beyond donation from contributors.

A grant of \$5000.00 would offset approximately one-third of the projected expense to purchase a reliable, multi-passenger, handicapped accessible van. We appreciate your consideration of our project.
