Tuxedo Park Baptist Church is located in the near Eastside of Indianapolis, Indiana. We are a small congregation of about 85 people in the middle of the worst part of Indy with robbery, prostitution, and drug activity being about 500 incidents each month within a mile radius of the church. We don't give up; our faith is strong and God is working miracles around us and through us all the time. We give all we possibly can and welcome everybody with open arms as they are, because we believe people deserve a second chance.

Our program is called "Bread N Word" because we feed the less fortunate in the community physically and spiritually every Thursday night. We serve 80 households each month at the Food Pantry. We are spending approximately \$300 each month to supplement foods in the Pantry. This is primarily at Gleaner's Food Bank and Aldi's Food stores. We get bread and one monthly "load out" at Midwest Food Bank at no cost. We try to have hygiene bags available in the Clothing Closet consisting of: soaps, toothpaste, toothbrush, razors, hair products, and other items, along with a Scripture card. These items must be purchased unless we can get them donated by individuals. We serve 40 families each month, with a cost of approximately \$275. Our weekly meal is served with 90% of the food donated through several catering companies. We serve between 60 and 80 meals each week. It takes a minimum of 15 volunteers to work each Thursday night, between the hours of 5 to 7 p.m. Of course some of us come to cook earlier in the day.

We have active Boy and Girl Scout programs and 3 AA groups meeting weekly at our church.

This grant would allow us to spend about \$415 each month to help the less fortunate in our community. The Missions Ministries makes up the difference, but our funding is minimal. If approved, we can continue our program and reach further into the community. Everything helps these days with how tight money has become. We always know our Heavenly Father will provide and has a plan for us. We feel we are a bridge that the community uses to cross over from poverty to self-sufficiency, giving them food and clothing to keep them from being totally homeless. We offer prayer support, and all are invited to our Sunday worship service. The money from this grant will be put to great use for the community on the near Eastside of Indianapolis. Thank you for your consideration of our program.
