PLAN FOR USAGE OF GRANT MONIES FOR LAKEWOOD BAPTIST CHURCH

Lakewood Baptist Church was approached in 2011 by Duane and Marcia Binkley asking if our church would consider becoming a church home for over 80 relocating refugees from the camps in Thailand to the Lakewood area. None of us could have imagined the blessings and challenges that would grow from accepting the Lord's calling.

Beginning in the summer of 2011, we joined together in worship, fellowship, and relationship-building. Most of our brothers and sisters from the refugee camps were Karen, though some were from other tribes as well. We were blessed to have several folks who spoke English in addition to their native language. Together we began to identify and tackle some of the needs of refugees resettling in the Cleveland/Lakewood area. Collaborating with other organizations, education became a priority need. Although many adults, youth, and children were learning English as a second language, the language challenges were an obstacle for many of our children and youth being educated in the public schools. Some tutoring was available in the community, but it was not sufficient.

The congregation at Lakewood Baptist Church began offering tutoring in the winter of 2012 for children and youth in grades 1 through 12. All tutors were/are volunteers from Lakewood Baptist Church and the community. We began this ministry with less than a dozen students total. Through word of mouth and community awareness, this ministry continues to grow. Last year we served an average of ten (10) children in grades kindergarten through fifth grade, and about a dozen in grades six through twelve. We anticipate continued growth, including other immigrants and refugee populations who have resettled in our community.

There is a growing need for more computer availability during tutoring. Our single computer at the church and limited internet does meet even our current needs. Our IT Coordinator has initiated technological improvements for the church as a whole (see first page of budget). The initial plan includes provide wireless internet accessibility for the entire church. If we are awarded grant money from the ABCUSA Matthew 25 Grant, we would be better equipped to meet the tutoring goals for our youth and children as listed below:

- We will increase the number of high school students receiving diplomas (instead of certificates of attendance).
- We will better communicate with students' teachers to identify homework and areas requiring more extensive assistance.
- 3. We would be able to assist students in practicing Ohio proficiency, college admission, reading comprehension, and even citizenship testing.
- We would be better able to proofread and offer tutoring assistance in students' preparation of essays and reports.
