FBC Bicknell has offered a "Free 4 Kids Clothing Giveaway" every July for the past several years. Many students in the North Knox School Corporation live in poverty. For example, North Knox Primary School is located across the street from FBC Bicknell and serves 308 students, 145 (or roughly 47%) of which are on free or reduced lunch. The FBC Bicknell Family is serving these families every year by purchasing brand-new clothing to hand out to students in the community, which builds self-esteem and prevents bullying for these impoverished children. Each child that is registered comes to FBC on the day of the giveaway and is assigned a personal shopper, whose task is not only to help the student shop for clothing but also to build a relational bridge with the child and their caregiver(s). The FBC fellowship hall is transformed into a clothing store of sorts, complete with changing rooms and clothing racks to simulate a real shopping experience for these children, many of whom have never before owned a NEW piece of clothing.

FBC's vision is clear: "We live to grow CHRIST'S Kingdom by passionately sharing His truth in love," and the clothing giveaway is just one important part of an overall strategy that involves a monthly free meal offered to the entire community, a coat giveaway for the North Knox students, food baskets at Christmas time, and weekly children's programming that includes dinner, Bible lessons, worship, and games.

The Matthew 25 Grant would empower FBC to serve more students at the clothing giveaway and subsequently introduce their families to all the other resources FBC currently offers. The FBC Mission Team does their best to locate great deals and work with local retailers on discounts, but new clothes for school are expensive. The church believes that clothing the children in our community actually means clothing Christ Himself and it's the joy of the Body of Christ to give the very best.
