Kindly accept Christian greetings. New Horizon Community Development Services is one of the ministries of New Horizon Baptist Church. For many years we have been serving the greater Hartford community in various ways; including the food and clothing ministries.

The city of Hartford, as you may be aware, is one of the needy areas in the United States. Statistically, it is in the top ten percent of the crime level, and eighty percent of the residents are living below the poverty line. Through the Community Development Services, we have been distributing food and clothing to needy people, serving children as well as adults.

Prior to the reopening of school in September each year, we sponsor a major community event called: "Back to School Community Day". Firstly, we would secure a rented space, notify the community by placing advertisements in the local papers, post flyers and send letters to residents. We would provide back packs with generous amounts of school supplies; and personal hygiene as well as household items would be distributed, all free of cost.

We also provide medical doctors and healthcare workers to present power points based on health topics, do blood pressure screenings and answer questions about health. We would also hire musicians, gospel singers would perform, Bibles from the Gideons would be distributed, and other groups from the community would be allowed to convey useful and relevant information. , Cooked meal is always provided for everyone, all free of cost.

At our last community day, we distributed one hundred and seventy five book bags with school supplies, unfortunately, some children had none, due to a short supply. These ministries have been a blessing to so many, due the fact that people are unemployed and most of them are living below the poverty line.

Parents as well as children have anticipated coming to "Community Day" due the fact that there is always something for every one. It places a smile on their faces, builds their hope, assist in their budgeting, lessens the crime, create a happier home environment and motivates them to say thanks. Thanks to New Horizon Community Development Services, and above all; thanks to God. As time progresses, we anticipate serving larger numbers, and with your assistance, we will be able to do so.

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
NEW HORIZON COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT SERVICES**

The undersigned incorporator(s) in order to form a corporate entity adopts the following articles of incorporation.

***ARTICLE I***

**NAME/REGISTERED OFFICE**

The name of this corporation shall be New Horizon Community Development Services located at 17 Essex Lane Bloomfield, CT 06002

***ARTICLE II***

**PURPOSE**

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes more specifically to food and clothing distribution, job training, literacy classes, housing development, educational workshops and any other charitable activity that furthers our mission in the community. To this end, the corporation shall at all times be operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended. All funds, whether income or principal, and whether acquired by gift or contribution or otherwise, shall be devoted to said purposes.

***ARTICLE III***

**EXEMPTION REQUIREMENTS**

At all times shall the following operate as conditions restricting the operations and activities of the corporation:

1. The corporation shall not afford pecuniary gain, incidentally or otherwise to its sole member (New Horizon Baptist Church) other than permissible by Section 501c3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986. No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of any board of director or sole member (New Horizon Baptist Church) of the corporation, except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the corporation affecting one or more of its purposes. Such net earnings, if any, of this corporation shall be used to carry out the nonprofit corporate purposes set forth in Article II above.
2. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall constitute the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or any initiative or referendum before the public, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including by
