# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF NEW HORIZON COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

The undersigned incorporator(s) in order to form a corporate entity adopts the following articles of incorporation.

### ARTICLE I

### NAME/REGISTERED OFFICE

The name of this corporation shall be New Horizon Community Development Services located at 17 Essex Lane Bloomfield, CT 06002

### ARTICLE II

### **PURPOSE**

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes more specifically to food and clothing distribution, job training, literacy classes, housing development, educational workshops and any other charitable activity that furthers our mission in the community. To this end, the corporation shall at all times be operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended. All funds, whether income or principal, and whether acquired by gift or contribution or otherwise, shall be devoted to said purposes.

### ARTICLE III

### **EXEMPTION REQUIREMENTS**

At all times shall the following operate as conditions restricting the operations and activities of the corporation:

- 1. The corporation shall not afford pecuniary gain, incidentally or otherwise to its sole member (New Horizon Baptist Church) other than permissible by Section 501c3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986. No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of any board of director or sole member (New Horizon Baptist Church) of the corporation, except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the corporation affecting one or more of its purposes. Such net earnings, if any, of this corporation shall be used to carry out the nonprofit corporate purposes set forth in Article II above.
- 2. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall constitute the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or any initiative or referendum before the public, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including by
