History

Recognizing the disturbing statistic that minority male youth are more likely to become incarcerated than educated, SIMBA was formed in the basement of St. Stephens Church, in 1993, with a group of less than 50 mentees and mentors combined. Understanding the importance of mentorship & positive images, SIMSA was formed in 2007. Today, we've served over 2,250 youth with the help of 720 volunteers. SIMBA and SIMSA fondly stands for Safe in my Brothers' / Sisters' Arms. There is a two and one week camp experience for African American youth ages 8-17. Held in rural locations, these camps are centered on youth developing healthy relationship skills that will help them cope with society's pressure to engage in inappropriate behaviors. There are also monthly sessions that focus on establishing positive relationships that serve as fundamental building blocks for successful navigation of through life.

Mission Statement

The SIMBA circle is an Afrocentric community grounded in the gospel of Jesus Christ that creates a space for listening, teaching, and responding to the needs of young African American males and females. We are determined to: Rescue their gifts, Release their potential and Restore their promise.

Target population served:

Poverty stricken and at risk families that lack the resources to provide their children with the opportunity to leave DeKalb and participate in a 1 to 2 week Christian based camping experience.

Specific Purpose of Funds Requested:

If granted the funds will be used to pay the camp cost for at least 12 youth to attend the; however, due to financial constraints can't afford to attend. The transportation, room and board will be provided for the amount of \$400 per child. Our goal is for approximately 40 children to attend the camp. Additionally, the purpose is to assist impoverished and underserved children to reach their academic standards and goals, as well as build their self-esteem by engaging them in Character development activities.

Expected Benefits and Outcomes of the Project:

The students will master the skills of basic fundamental academics, motor and social skills, gardening, choir, drama, computer literacy and character development.
