Specific Purpose of Funds Requested:

Purchase a Smart Board, Installation, and Projector to assist impoverished and underserved children to reach their academic standards and goals. Also, the children will experience the cultural diversity and character development in the community and internationally due to the excess of the internet and high technology.

Expected Benefits and Outcomes of the Project:

We commit ourselves to welcoming and accepting all people, nurturing academic and social development, and providing love and support for everyone. We provide the means for everyone to achieve and grow as an accomplished individual through the Academy's effort.

HISTORY

Mrs. Brenda J. Donley of New Hope Missionary Baptist Church located in DeKalb, Illinois launched New Hope Youth Academy on June 22, 2010. Academy began by serving 18 students during the summer program, and by the summer's end we had actually serviced 41 students. The children were provided with tutoring to improve their reading and math skills. Each student was served a meal and later a snack at every session. The Academy has grown and presently serves approximately 300 children and adults annually. We now operate year around. The New Hope Youth Academy has since changed the name to: New Hope Academy.

New Hope Academy's curriculum initially included reading, math and the components of character development. Presently the curriculum includes the following: Reading, Math, English Composition, Chess, Gardening, Nutrition, Philanthropy, Exercise, Piano, Drums, Advanced - Individualized Tutoring in Writing and Math, Sign Language I, Test Preparation (ACT, Basic skills, and the US & State Constitutions), Leadership and Career Preparation, Character Development components, and Hair Styling I for Girls. The resulting accomplishments of New Hope Academy include improvements in the children's reading and math assessment scores, social behaviors which include problem solving techniques, and conflict resolution. Consequently student's modified behavior has resulted in fewer disciplinary actions, with no expulsions. Also noteworthy are, several of the children have achieved honor roll status beyond single quarters, and would maintained such status throughout entire year.

Since its conception the Teaching Staff for New Hope Academy has been both dedicated and loyal. In the history of the Academy the Staff has been 100% volunteers, with the exception of one summer in 2011. However, we're now again at 100%. At the end of each year the Academy celebrate the students, and Teaching Staff for all of their hard work, and contribution of time and help that continue to make New Hope Academy a success year after year. The entire New Hope Missionary Church and the DeKalb County community have supported the efforts of the Academy with monetary funds as well as time, energy and effort, for without which we would not survive.
