A generous donor has given a sum of money through American Baptist Churches USA to be used for programs that address "housing, feeding, education and health with regard to the less fortunate." A discernment team will select recipients for grants of up to \$5,000 largely based on the degree to which the funds will be used to directly assist persons in poverty. Ministries must be in relationship with American Baptist Churches USA to be eligible to apply, and only one application per church or ministry will be considered per year. Grant funds may not be used to fund staff positions.

Milton Baptist Backpack Ministry

The Backpack Ministry at Milton Baptist Church works to provide food for students who might go hungry or have little to eat over the weekend, while away from school. We fill bags with a variety of foods that are easy for the children to prepare such as cereal, juice, poptarts, fruits cups, oats, and soups.

This will be the fourth year we have provided a Backpack Ministry for children in poverty at our local elementary school. The first year we supplied food to twenty-five students, who had been identified by the faculty and staff at the school, to be handed out on Fridays. The second year our numbers grew as we provided for fifty-one students. Last year we again increased the number of students we provided for to eighty-one at the elementary level and expanded the ministry to the middle school averaging twelve students. We anticipate that once again our numbers will increase making our need to supply food to these children even greater.

As an extension to our program we have an Angel Tree ministry for these children where members of our church and community "adopt" a child and buy Christmas presents for him/her. Our Backpack Ministry also packs food for the families of these children to insure they have a complete meal for Christmas and some other foods to help get them through the holidays.

Our goal is to provide nutrition for the children when they are away from school so they do not return to school hungry at the beginning of the next week. We hope these students return to school more alert and ready to focus on learning. The money from this grant would go to help purchase the food supplies so we can continue to help these children to become more healthy and successful students and hopefully productive adults in the future.
