

ABCUSA MATTHEW 25 GRANT APPLICATION

A generous donor has given a sum of money through American Baptist Churches USA to be used for programs that address "housing, feeding, education and health with regard to the less fortunate." A panel will select recipients for grants of up to \$5,000 largely based on the degree to which the funds will be used to directly assist persons in poverty. Ministries must be in relationship with American Baptist Churches USA to be eligible to apply, and only one application per church or ministry will be considered per year. Grant funds may not be used to fund staff positions.

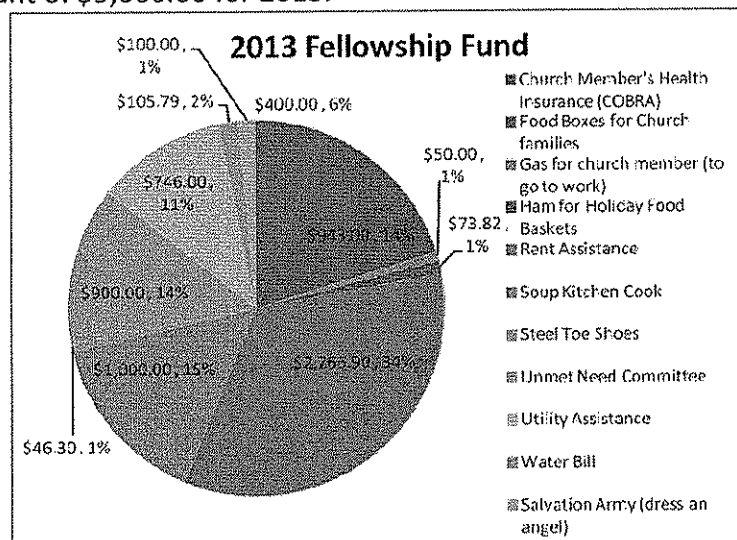


Plan to Use the Requested Funds: The Deacons and Deaconesses of Central Baptist Church plan to use all of the requested funds (100%) to confidentially address "housing, feeding, education and health with regard to the less fortunate." The "Servants of the Table" will accomplish this goal through two important community assistance programs:

1. **Quincy Area Partnership for Unmet Needs:** Central Baptist Church, other area churches, and the social service agencies in Adams County, Illinois, developed a unique cooperative plan in 1993 to address economic needs among our neighbors called the "Quincy Area Partnership for Unmet Needs." The mission of the Quincy Area Partnership "complement the social service system by compassionately responding through networking and collaborative funding provided by individual agencies, churches and human service organizations to meet the needs of individuals in our community that may exceed the limits of any agency."

Professionally trained caseworkers present requests from clients to the Unmet Need Committee every-other Wednesday at the Office of the Adams County United Way. Requests must be documented, screened, and exceed government and social service agency funds; or requests are presented which are not funded by other grants or tax revenue. Area churches partner together to address these "unmet needs" by pledging their financial support from their benevolence offerings. All funds (100%)

2. **Fellowship Fund:** Central Baptist Church partners with the Unmet Need Committee, as well as, fully funds financial assistance requests submitted by community members and its members through its monthly communion benevolence offerings. The church provides monthly food baskets to low-income families in partnership with the Smart Choice Food Program, monthly assistance for the community Soup Kitchen which feeds low-income families each week day at noon, rent assistance, utility and water assistance; in addition to the funds donated through the Unmet Need Committee. The church's community assistance program has dramatically increased from a thousand dollars each year to a projected amount of \$9,000.00 for 2013.
