Grant funds may not be used to fund staff positions.

Iglesia Bautista Comunidad Luz y Vida is a young congregation in Moorefield, WV. The church began ministering to Hispanic immigrants from Mexico, Honduras, Dominican Republic, and Puerto Rico 5 years ago. These Hispanic immigrants relocate to the town of Moorefield seeking work in the chicken processing plant Pilgrim’s Pride. The Hispanic community in Moorefield is composed of people with documents and those without documents. Women without documents are very vulnerable to financial challenges and exploitation because of their legal status.

We are requesting the Matthew 25 grant funds which will provide seed money to enable us to train and teach 10 Hispanic women to manufacture handmade soaps and creams. Upon learning this new skill these women will be able to sell their product to earn an income that will complement their low income.

The West Virginia Baptist Convention has a mission partnership with the Iglesias Bautistas de Puerto Rico. Sister Sara Díaz González from Iglesia Bautista de Mamey owns a business and is willing to come to West Virginia as a volunteer to share her knowledge and teach this craft these women. Our goal is to distribute the products through our network of churches in the West Virginia Baptist Convention and where the Lord opens doors.

The \$2800.00 dollars requested will purchase the materials that will be used to teach the women this new trade. Below follows a description.

Detailed procedure

Materials for 6 medium size soaps:

- 1 pound of glycerine
- 2 ounces of fragrance
- 1 vitamine E capsule of 400mg
- 1 ounce of color for 6 soaps

Materials for 8 medium size soaps:

- 2 pounds of glycerine
- 3 ounces of fragrance
- 1 vitamine E capsule of 400mg
- 2 ounce of color for 8 soaps

Note: 24 pounds of glycerine make approximately 80 soaps. This depends on the mold used to make the soap.
