Grant funds may not be used to fund staff positions or stipends, rainy day funds, church benevolent funds, regular ongoing church operating expenses (i.e. utilities, insurance), repairs, or for capital improvements or repairs to facilities. Grant awards will be sent to the ABC church that is applying for the grant; checks will not be made payable to an individual or ministry.

When determining Grants awards, the following criteria will be considered: whether the church is in good standing within the region; whether the church contributes to United Mission; number of and amounts of previous Matthew 25 Grants received; sustainability of ministry beyond Matthew 25 Grant funding; description of ministry and needs addressed by funding; and the detailed budget submitted along with this application.

Checks will be made payable to the ABC church. Checks will not be made to an individual or ministry.

- 3. SPECIFICALLY, HOW DO YOU PLAN TO USE THE REQUESTED FUNDS? In 2018 we were able to buy 80 backpacks full of school supplies, and we ran out about one hour into our Community Festival outreach event. In 2019 we hope to buy 200 backpacks with school supplies so we can hand them out to each of the children who attend this yearly event. (This event reaches out to our community, which is comprised of about 90% low-income families who are on some sort of assistance. Everything we do is 100% FREE to the community (food, live music, jumpers, carnival games, family activities, raffles, etc). But the MAIN FOCUS of the event is to EMPOWER the community by exposing them to non-profit organizations we partner with [e.g., safety, health, legal, counseling, education, social services, childcare, etc].)
- 4. How will the funds assist individuals battling with poverty and its effects? The funds will help our local families (about 90% of which are low-income) by enabling the students to make the most of their current education, which would otherwise not be as feasible due to the lack of basic educational supplies needed for homework and every-day school use. This will demonstrate to the families that others do care and are willing to stand side-by-side with them to ensure their success. We expect this will also open the doors for more students to take advantage of our pre-K and before- and after-school ministry. Ultimately, we hope our ongoing effort will lead to higher education, which will truly take students and their families out of poverty and put them on a leadership path that will help them make a more empowering contribution back to our community.
