In consideration of the Attendee's desire to participate in the event, Attendee hereby voluntarily agrees to accept all of the foregoing risks and hereby waives, covenants not to sue, releases and forever discharges any and all claims for personal injuries, illnesses, property damage or loss that Attendee may have against ABCUSA and its directors, officers, members, agents, employees, contractors, representatives and volunteers in any way associated with the employer ("Releasees") that may arise directly or indirectly, foreseeably or unforeseeably, from the Attendee's travel to or from, lodging at or participation in meetings associated with the event. Attendee acknowledges that if a Court determines that part of this document is inadmissible that the remaining paragraphs shall remain in full force and effect.

7. Attendee acknowledges that, by entering into this agreement, Attendee is not relying on any oral or written representation or statements made by ABCUSA or any of the Releasees other than that set forth in this agreement.
